1. Entrants must observe all applicable rules and regulations and follow instructions from police and parade officials or be barred from the parade. The OV PWD Parade Committee reserve the right to remove any entrant from the parade either prior to assembly, while assembling or any time during the parade.
2. **NO MATERIALS MAY BE THROWN ALONG THE PARADE ROUTE. Entrants may have a person(s) walking alongside entrants to hand out candy, necklaces or other promotional materials to bystanders. No water balloons or water guns. Violation will result in suspension.**
3. Forward movement maneuvers only by marching units are permitted. No units may stop forward motion for performances except in the areas designated by the OV PWD Parade Committee. This stop may not exceed 90 seconds.
4. A space of 50 feet between each unit will be enforced. All units are required to close gap between units when instructed by parade officials. Failure to do so may warrant removal from the parade.
5. Alcoholic beverages are forbidden on any float, in any vehicle, or on the person of any participant. Participants consuming alcohol prior to or during the parade will be removed from the lineup. All city, county and CA State statues concerning the consumption of alcoholic beverages will be strictly enforced by the police before, during and after the parade.
6. Drivers of any and all vehicles in the parade areas must possess a valid driver's license, be at least 18 years old, and possess all liability vehicle insurance.
7. **Livestock, reptiles, wild and domestic animals shall not be in the parade unless special written approval by the OV PWD Parade Committee is obtained.** If approval is granted, all horses must have someone to clean up, if necessary, along the parade route.
8. Use high intensity sound making devices is strongly discouraged. Sound of any type must be approved by the OV PWD Parade Committee and must be at a compatible sound level. Officials have the complete authority in this matter and reserve the right to withdraw any unit that does not comply with their instructions to turn down or turn off sound when instructed to do so. Failure to comply with the officials' instructions will result in immediate removal from the parade and jeopardize future participation.
9. The OV PWD Parade Committee reserves the right to withdraw any unit of which costume or performance does not meet the parade rules and regulations or conform to the standards of reasonable public taste and fit the parade theme.
10. Entrants that do not appear on parade day without prior notification to parade officials or entries that do not comply with the rules and regulations jeopardize future participation in the OV POW WOW DAYS Parade. No refunds on registration fees.
11. The OV PWD Parade Committee's decision regarding all entries is final.
12. The OV PWD Parade Committee does not accept the responsibility for travel, food, or lodging expense of any unit.
13. Application fees are non-refundable for accepted entries. Each entry must pay the appropriate fee.
14. The OV PWD Parade Committee reserves the right to accept or decline any entry.
15. No water balloons, water cannons or water guns may be used during the parade.
16. NO Nudity

FLOATS

1. Only vehicles pulling floats or providing transportation for pageant entries will be allowed in the parade. Exceptions will be considered for antique vehicles and other organized specialty car groups with prior approval. Vehicles that are pulling floats should be incorporated as much as possible into the float and decorated accordingly.
2. All entries must be decorated according to OV PWD theme. All banners must be neatly lettered and legible. Sketches of homemade floats must be submitted along with the application. The sketch should include all parts of the float, including towing vehicle.
3. NO decorations and or float construction material may protrude from the side of the float. All electrical devices must be properly grounded.
4. All floats must have handholds or standup holds for each rider on the float. Any self-propelled float must have a spotter beside the float, who is in two-way communication with the float driver.
5. No participants may jump on a float to ride and not interfere with any other unit in any way. Float capacity will not be exceeded. No participants will dismount from a float during the parade route. Participants will not have body parts, particularly legs and feet, extending past the sides, front or rear of the float. This is an extreme safety hazard.
6. Float platforms should be at least 7 feet wide and 15 feet long with a fixed axle at/near the rear and a steer able axle at the front. Farm wagons make excellent platforms. Single or tandem axle trailers normally pulled by a car or truck are not desirable.



Cont. Rules and Regulations

BANDS – MARCHING/WALKING UNITS

1. All marching units must maintain forward motion. Routines that cause gaps will not be permitted. Stopping or reversing motion will result in removal from the parade and will jeopardize future participation. No unit may stop forward motion to perform except in areas designated by the OV PWD Parade Committee. Performance stops may not last more than 90 seconds.
2. If for any reason a gap of greater than 50 feet is created, marching units must increase their pace to close the gap.
3. Walling groups must be dressed in uniform that easily identifies walkers as a part of the same group.
4. No vehicle may accompany marching units without written approval.

LINEUP

All entries will line-up by entering on Main Avenue from Madison Avenue. Entries will be instructed on parade route placement.

KINGS/QUEENS

Kings/Queens from any Elementary, Jr. High, High School, College or recognized pageant will be considered for the parade at the discretion of the OV PWD Parade Committee. Eligible entries for consideration will include private/public, elementary/secondary, college institutions and recognized pageant winners. Kings/Queens must be at least 5 years old. Kings/Queens from the same school must ride in the same convertible. Kings/Queens are required to furnish their own convertibles. The driver must be at least 18 years old and have a valid driver's license. A maximum of 2 persons per vehicle (driver excluded) only. The King and/or Queen must have been selected as a part of an official school pageant. The King/Queen must attend the school they represent.

JUDGING

1. Entrants will be judged in the following eight categories:

- Community Service Group
- Community Youth Group
- Musical & Dance
- Vehicle - Auto
- Horse
- Color Guard
- Business
- Novelty
- Mayor's Choice

2. Judging will be based on the

- following: Originality/Creativity
- General Appearance
- Incorporation of Theme

3. Judges scores will be combined and will be final.

ROUTE

The parade will start from the assembly area on Main Avenue in Orangevale (Between Madison Ave and Greenback Lane.) Parade Entries must enter from Madison Ave. It will proceed east on Greenback Lane to Divine Savior Church- 9079 Greenback Lane, Orangevale. Route is 1 mile. Further instructions regarding staging will be provide after entry acceptance.

IMPORTANT PARADE INFORMATION!

We are so glad that you will be a part of the **49th Annual Pow Wow Days Parade** on Saturday, May 19, 2012.

Staging and Parade Route:

The parade will begin promptly at 9:00 a.m. Enclosed is the map:

Staging area where your parade unit should report to; *it is essential that your entire group report to your designated area NO LATER THAN 8:30 a.m. on May 19th*. All groups (other than horse entries) will stage on Main Avenue between Greenback and Madison Ave. **PLEASE DO NOT STAGE OR MEET IN ANY PARKING LOT** (unless other arrangements have been made). Have your group enter the staging area from Main Avenue. Please make sure all trash and items are clean before leaving the staging area. Failure to leave the staging area clean will result in suspension.

Please share this information with your group.

We will have a sign with your entry name – please have somebody ready to carry the sign. Please pick up your entry sign at the information booth located near Schools Credit Union. **Don't forget to designate someone to pick up your entry sign!!** If you choose not to carry the sign, the announcer at the reviewing stand will not be able to announce information about your group and the judging committee will not be able to include your entry in the judging.

Judging

Judging will begin at 9:00 a.m. so it is essential for your group to be in place in your designated staging area by that time if you want to be judged. The awards will be announced at Orangevale Pow Wow Days on Sunday, May 20, 2012 at 12 noon. **IMPORTANT** – Please **do not** stop to perform at the reviewing stand. Following are the categories that are being judged;
